Since the Fall of Adam and Eve, brokenness has defined the human condition.

When we look around, we see a world that is broken. A world where people hurt others and themselves. A world where nothing seems to last forever.

How should we, as the people of God, respond to this brokenness? Should we try to fix it? Should we turn a blind eye? Or should we console ourselves by saying, “All will be well when we go to heaven”? For the ancient people of God, brokenness was very real, and they responded by praying the Psalms.

The Psalms paint a picture of what it looks like to struggle with the sin, suffering and death of this world. They give us language to express the pain we feel. They guide us from sin to confession, from suffering to fellowship, and from death to submission.

So come, people of God, let us shema the Psalms as they speak for us in our mourning, our grieving, and our lament.

He previously worked in law firms, academia, and consulting in Melbourne, Hong Kong, and Singapore, including a 12-year stint teaching business law at NTU.



Benny later obtained graduate degrees in law as well as theology. Recent books he helped edit or author include: Singapore Business Law (9th ed., 2021); and Renewal Through Restoration: An Uncommon Call to Christian Discipleship (2021).

Benny directs the Klesis Institute, a ministry serving non-denominational Churches of Christ in Australia. Benny is married to Pauline, a Singapore-born homemaker and volunteer counsellor, and they have four children. In their spare time, Benny and Pauline enjoy reading, gardening, movies, and travel.



Church Camp T-Shirt

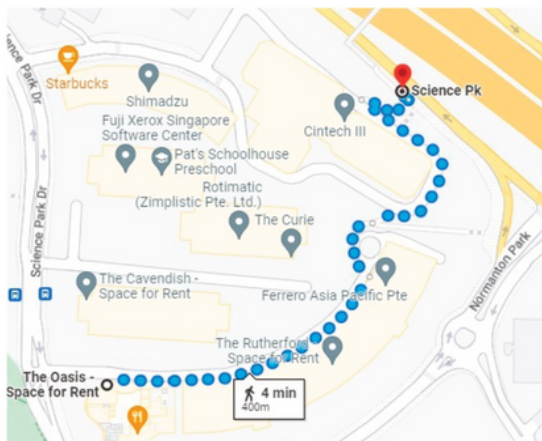

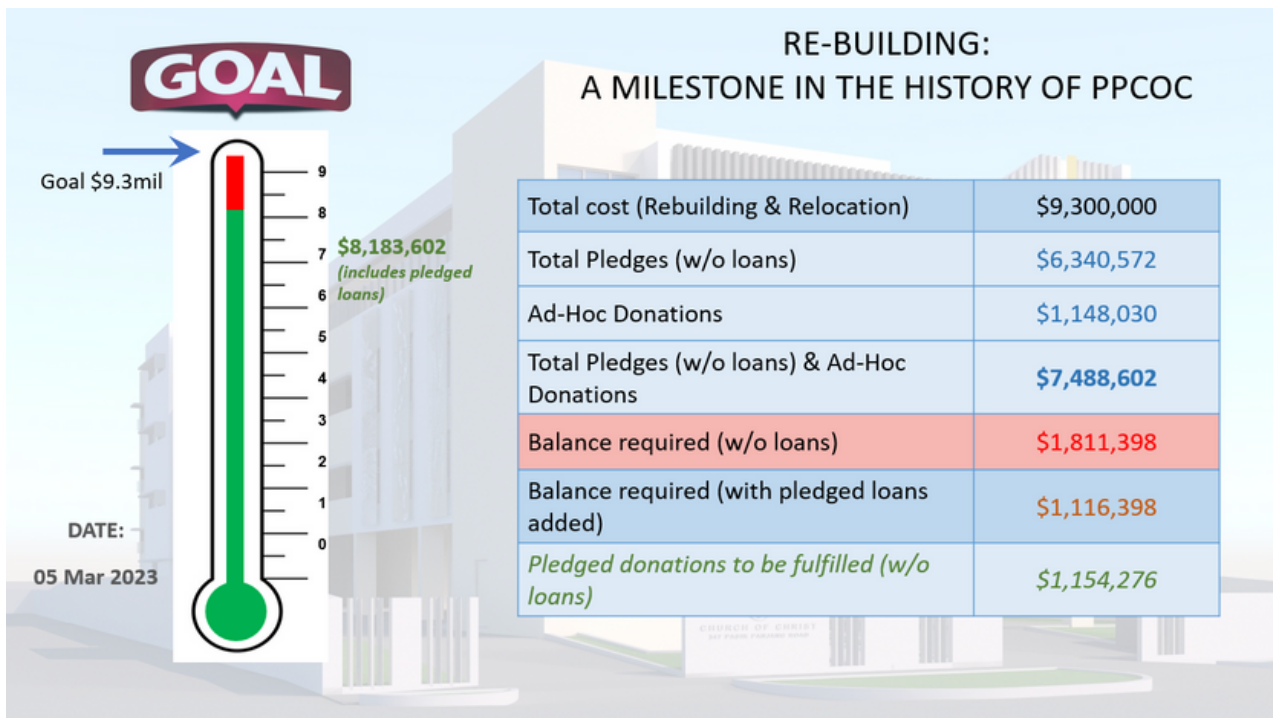
