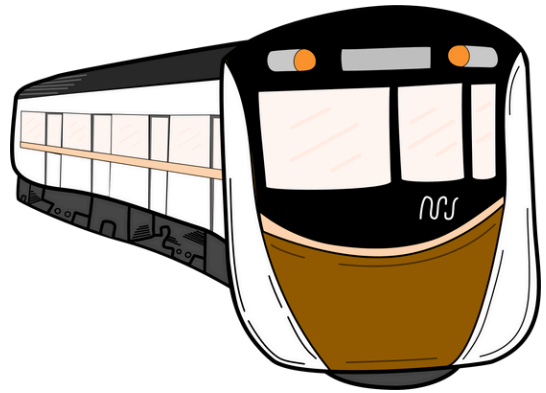

Recap: Asian Mission Forum 2025

From August 1-5, the 62nd Asia Mission Forum convened in Cebu, Philippines, bringing together approximately 110 overseas guests alongside dozens of local church members for a powerful time of worship, learning, and fellowship. Our congregation was well-represented with 10 members in attendance: KC Cheang, Peggy Puah, Grace and Michael Mariarajah, Siew Gek Chua, elder Simon Goh, and the Hooper family.



The forum's theme of "Building God's Kingdom" resonated deeply with attendees, drawing inspiration from the book of Nehemiah and the unity required to accomplish God's work. As Michael M reflected, "Like in Nehemiah's time, the people united to build—with one heart and one purpose. 'The wall was completed... because the people had a mind to work' (Nehemiah 4:6; 6:15)."

Our members returned enriched and inspired by the experience. Brother KC Cheang described it as "perhaps the most enriching AMF I've attended," while sister Grace M. called it "a spiritual, social, and intellectual feast" with practical takeaways for everyone. The fellowship extended beyond formal sessions, with opportunities to reconnect with former SIBI students and learn from various outreach ministries.





Recap: Asian Mission Forum 2025 (cont.)

A standout message came from David Allen's lesson on "The Power of Kingdom Collaboration," emphasizing the importance of clear vision, teamwork, and humble leadership. As sister Siew Gek Chua noted, "When there's pride and jealousy, [we] leave no room for The Holy Spirit to unite us with Christ."

The children's program ensured that even our youngest attendees could participate meaningfully in this gathering of believers from across Asia. The forum served as a powerful reminder that God's kingdom is built through unity, collaboration, and shared commitment to His mission.

On the final day, it was announced that a team from Chiang Mai would host next year's 63rd AMF, with tentative dates 24-28 July and venue to be confirmed early in 2026.

May we carry forward the spirit of Nehemiah's builders—working together with one heart and one purpose to advance God's kingdom in our community and beyond.
