What they are celebrating:

I thank God for His faithfulness this past year. Though I could not afford my wife's IVF treatment, the Lord graciously opened a door through PPCOC. In ministry, I was blessed to give Bible training to 12 students—7 are now serving in different places for His Kingdom, and 5 are working alongside me. By God's grace, I also baptized four people and continue teaching children and new believers, many of them coming from Hindu and Muslim backgrounds. We praise God for adding souls to His Kingdom!

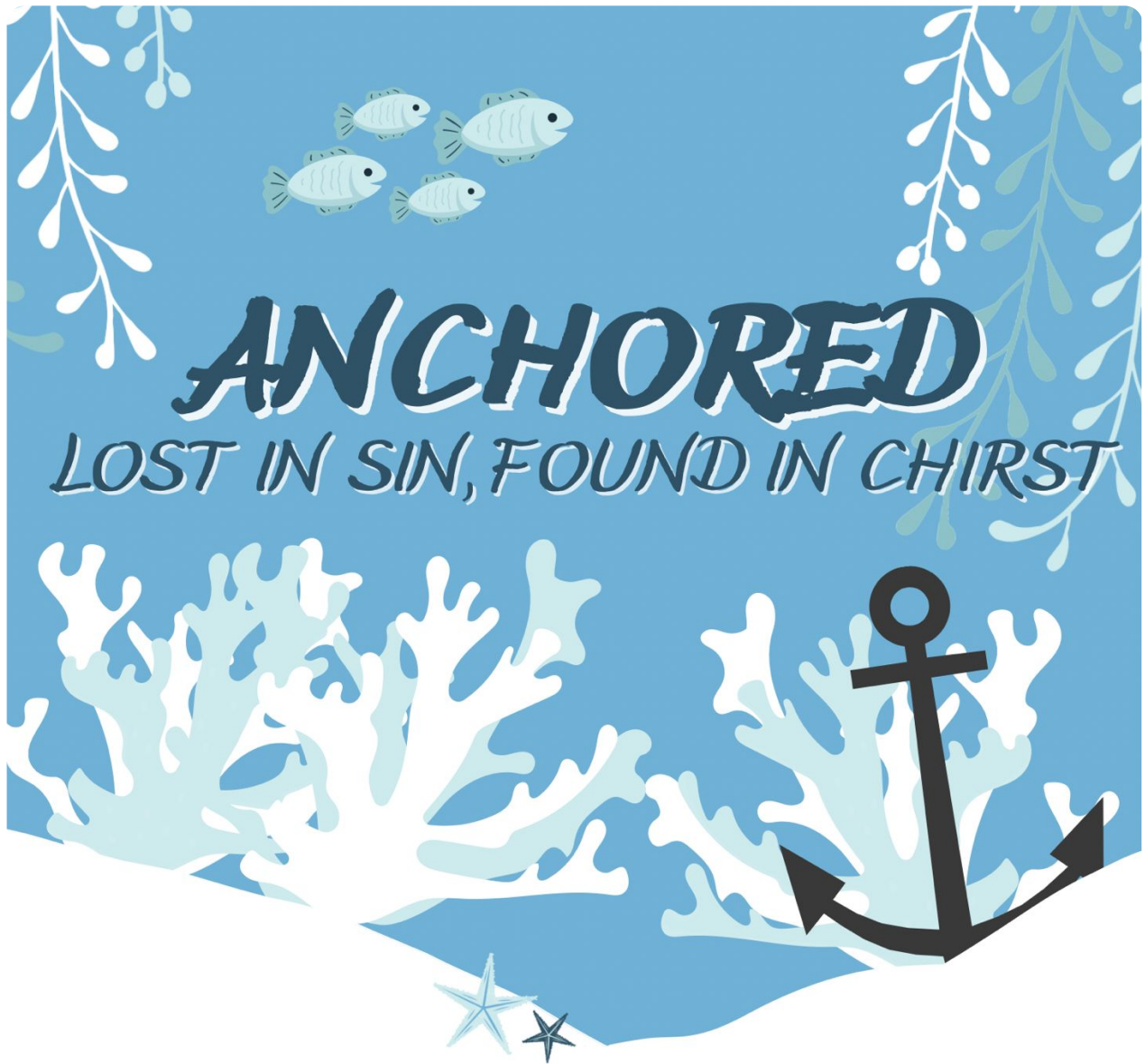
How we can pray for them:
