Mission Partner Spotlight



Lae, Papua New Guinea

Arthur Tatara

Arthur Tatara, a Bible instructor at Melanesian Bible College for eight years, is also a pulpit minister at MBC-Church of Christ in Lae, Morobe province. He

passionately conducts Bible classes for secondary school students weekly. While previously ministering in rural Morobe province, recent challenges have paused his travel efforts until now. He also continues to serve his home village by going back to Waria Valley for their annual camp every December.

What they are celebrating:

Arthur is celebrating the National Court's decision to sentence James Mon from Kumaru village to five years hard labor for his role as a community leader supporting the mob torture and murder of Lorna. This case has opened opportunities for Arthur to network with the US Embassy and PNG government to combat sorcery-related violence in PNG. Arthur is also celebrating his students who graduated with diplomas in basic bible studies and are now serving in their home congregations. Above all, Arthur celebrates God's goodness and faithfulness in the ministry where he shares God's love with those he encounters.

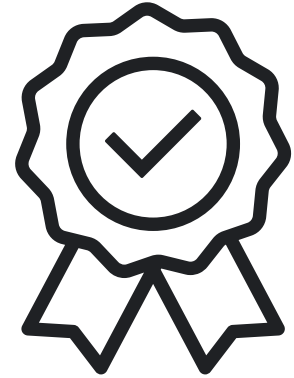
How we can pray for them:

Arthur requests prayer for his health and safety as Papua New Guinea prepares to celebrate its 50th Jubilee this month amid widespread law and order issues. People are killing each other without reason while mothers and children are dying in rural areas due to lack of health services. Arthur also asks for prayer for the 7th Morobe Provincial Youth Camp and fundraising efforts.



LPA Certification

On Saturday 27 September, the Seniors Ministry (Talks Interest Group) organised a webinar on Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA) that was attended by about 30 members and visitors. We're thankful to have our very own Bro Joel Loh, a practicing lawyer, conduct an informative session.



In short, a “will” only takes effect upon death but an LPA takes effect if someone is still alive but mentally incapacitated. As such, an LPA is recommended for anyone above 21 years old to plan for future decision-making in case they become mentally incapacitated due to illness or injury. It enables appointed persons to manage personal welfare, property and finances on their behalf, avoiding the need for time consuming and costly court proceedings.

The Singapore government has waived the \$75 registration fee for an LPA till 31 March 2026. For the attendees of the Talk who wish to have their LPA (Form 1) certified by Bro Joel Loh in his capacity as a lawyer, please register your interest with Sis Mee Geok or Sis Keng Geok.

In place of a certification fee, Bro Joel Loh has requested that a donation of \$30 be made to our PPCOC Building Fund instead. If you are not an attendee of the Talk but wish to apply for an LPA, you may approach a doctor or a lawyer to have it certified.

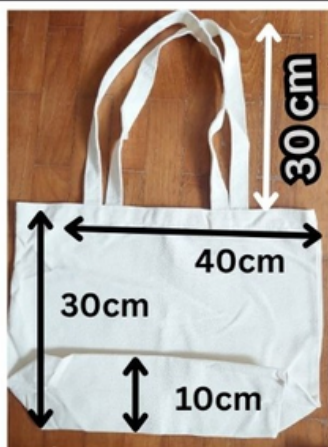

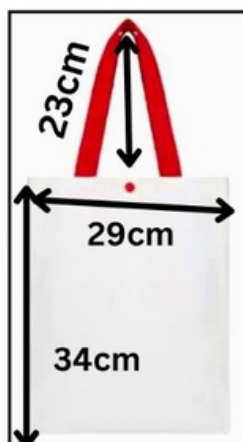
