Jojo and Janet Ramos have dedicated 19 years as Pauline missionaries with PP and Midtown Church of Christ. They focus on engaging, equipping, and empowering emerging leaders with discipleship, Spiritual formation, and leadership in the Cordillera Mountains, Manila, Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao Regions. Internationally, they minister to Filipino Diasporas to be influencers for Christ where God has scattered them, aiming to start a global Disciple Making Movement embodying the Pauline mission methodology.

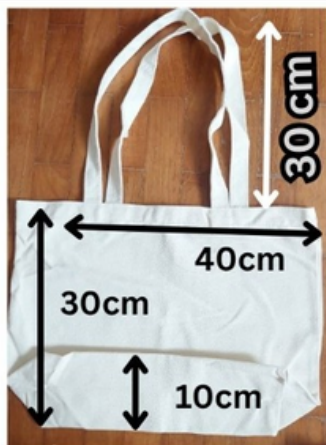

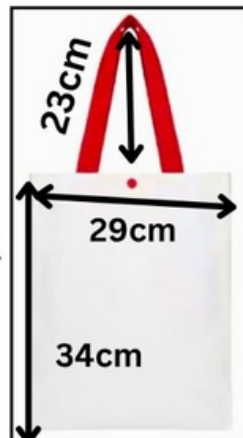

Mission Trip Sharing

September 25-30 | Gollaprollu COC

The team recently partnered with Bro Joel Madiki and the Gollaprollu Church of Christ (GPCOC) in India to co-host their first Women's and Young Girls' Prayer Conference. Under the theme "Faithful Knees = Fruitful Lives," they shared nine lessons over 2.5 days, encouraging believers to depend on God through faithful prayer for spiritual growth and community transformation.



Highlights

The team was deeply moved by the faith and humility of the Indian sisters. Despite kneeling on graveled ground in discomfort, women of all ages—including those in their 80s—prayed fervently with tears and unwavering trust in God.



Peggy reflected, "Even women in the 80s did not shy away and faithfully knelt down to pray with quiet determination and strength from God. Their faith to be totally submissive to God was inspirational given their poverty, environmental and social instability."

Siew Gek added, "I was also awestruck by the ladies kneeling on the stony ground and tearfully lifting prayers to God. Such great faith of the old and young alike touched my heart."

The workshop included meaningful activities, such as symbolically breaking down "walls" of worry through prayer, village home visits, and a bonus session on healthy living. Though the trip was marked by the sudden passing of GPCOC co-pastor Yesu-Ratnam in a traffic accident, the team witnessed God's providence throughout and were blessed to visit Bro Kiran's family to show their love and support.
