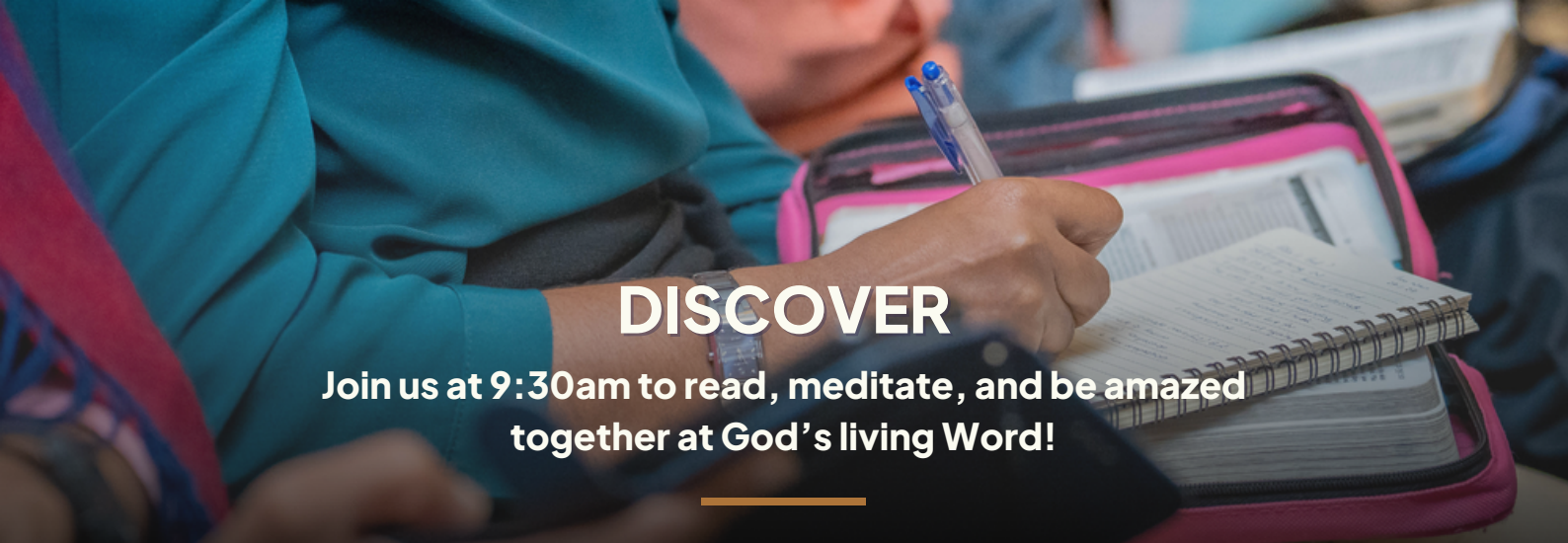

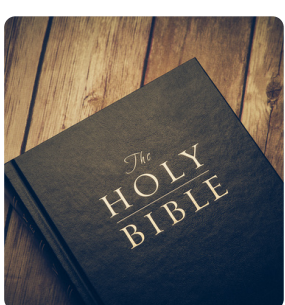

India Mission Team Reflections (8–17 Dec 25)

A team of five from PPCOC—Kyle, Grace, Michael, Aaron, and Jan—traveled to India to encourage our mission partners and connect with believers across three locations.

In Gollaprolu, the team partnered with Joel Madiki to lead workshops for couples on serving God together and for youth on staying rooted in faith. The team spent time prayer walking through the village and was deeply moved by how many people came into the streets inviting them to pray over their families—a reminder of Jesus ministering to people in the towns he visited. The team also met a family who has been replicating PPCOC's VBS model for several years and seeing fruit in remote villages.

In Guntur, the team encouraged Kiran Babu's congregation through youth teaching, family visits, and a leadership seminar. They celebrated a baptism for a new sister in Christ. On Sunday, the team joined the congregation for worship where Kyle shared from Colossians 1:10, followed by a fellowship meal together.

In Bangalore, the team met with Prashanth Alam to learn about his disciple-making ministry and provide pastoral encouragement to him and his family.

Please pray for Joel, Kiran, and Prashanth as they train leaders and disciple believers. Pray for their protection amid increasing pressures on the church in India, and that PPCOC can continue walking alongside these faithful workers.

Arrival & Fellowship (Vizag & Kakinada)

We arrived in Visakhapatnam (Vizag), stayed the night, and travelled the next day to Kakinada to stay with Brother Joel family. We were deeply thankful for two dedicated drivers who journeyed tirelessly with us throughout our mission in Andhra Pradesh.

On our first evening, a missionary family, Mr and Mrs. Prasant Kumar and his 2 daughters travelled from Vizag for more than four hours just to meet and to get to know us. This is one of the congregations where PPCOC - 2019 VBS team planted the seeds. Since then, they have done multiple VBS and women ministry in several location. Their passion for God's work deeply encouraged us — especially one of their young daughters, who joyfully shared how they benefited and how they now conducts the VBS and serves in women's ministry alongside her father.

Youth Fellowship at Gollapuru Church

We participated in a youth fellowship organised by Brother Joel. The youths and young adults of Gollapuru Church were a great encouragement to us. We spent time sharing, listening, laughing, praying, and building brotherly love. Serving great meal and eating together strengthened our fellowship in Christ.

Village Walks & Prayer Ministry

Walking through Gollapuru village was one of the most moving experiences of the trip. Many families and individuals called out to us for prayers — for health, pain, and personal struggles. Despite living in difficult conditions, their faith and hope in God were evident.

We split into smaller groups to pray from house to house, witnessing God's Spirit at work among His people.

Serving the Needy (Rajahmundry & Guntur)

On our way to Guntur, we visited Brother Emmanuel in Rajahmundry. We were blessed to distribute saris to the elderly women, widows, and the poor. Brother Emmanuel also manages an elderly care home, and we were privileged to help feed hundreds from nearby villages.

Encouraging the Churches (Vijayawada & Reddy Palem)

As our journey continued, we took the opportunity to visit Brother Vijay Rao and his family at Ibrahim Patnam Church of Christ, where PPCOC - 2020 VBS team had previously conducted VBS there. We now see, even his 2 daughters-in-law are active serving in women's and children's ministry, and at the same time helping with the children's orphanage there. That same night, we travelled to Guntur, Reddy Palem to visit Brother Kiran Babu.

The next morning, we spent meaningful time with youths, families, and individuals at the church — encouraging them to grow closer to God, remain faithful, and stay connected to the church.

A Joyful Baptism

We were privileged to witness a sister's baptism (from Reddy Palem COC)— a joyful and humbling moment for all of us. Though the journey was long, rejoicing together in her obedience to Christ made it truly worthwhile.

We also attended Sunday worship, dressed in traditional Indian attire (gifted by Sister Ruth for all), and prayed with many members of the Reddy Palem COC who sought encouragement and healing.

Our Final Stop: Bengaluru

Our final destination was to fly to Bengaluru to meet Brother Prasant. Despite last-minute changes to our travel plans (changes to the flight and the date), God provided a way and guided us safely.

This mission journey reminded us that God is powerfully at work in India, using faithful servants to touch lives in ways both seen and unseen. We return grateful, humbled, and encouraged by the faith, sacrifice, and love of our brothers and sisters in Christ.
