Growing Forward: Embracing Our Asian Heritage in Gospel Mission

An Honor-Shame Workshop with Dr. Chris Flanders

Western missionaries brought us the gospel with deep sacrifice and love. Yet along with the good news came cultural frameworks—individualism, guilt-innocence, and American norms—that shaped how we read Scripture and engage in mission.

This workshop invites Singaporean and Malaysian Christians to rediscover the richness of our Asian heritage—honor-shame dynamics, communal identity, and relational wisdom—and explore how these can deepen our gospel witness.

Singapore is uniquely positioned: nearly half its residents are non-citizens, making our neighborhoods a vibrant mission field. We don’t need to cross oceans to be missionaries; we can embody the gospel right here, in our own backyard.
