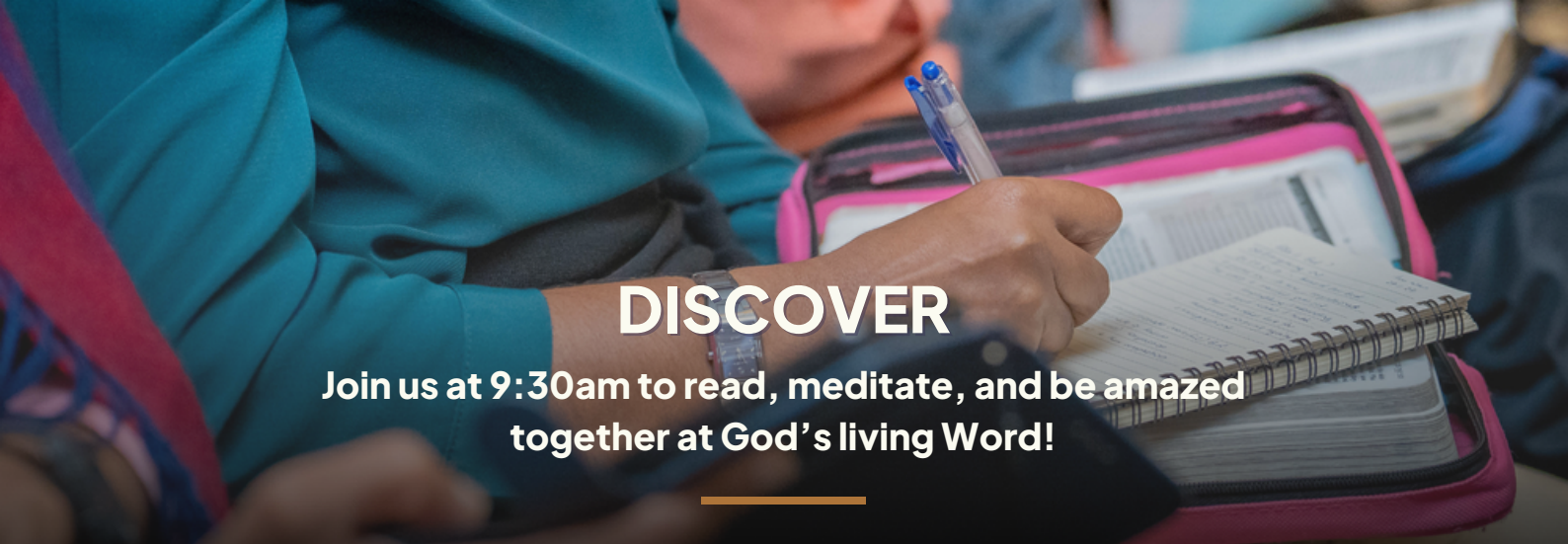

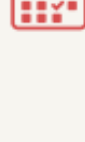

God invites us to be wise stewards of the things He gives us. For those of us who have been blessed abundantly with material things, let us use them to bring New Beginnings with others!

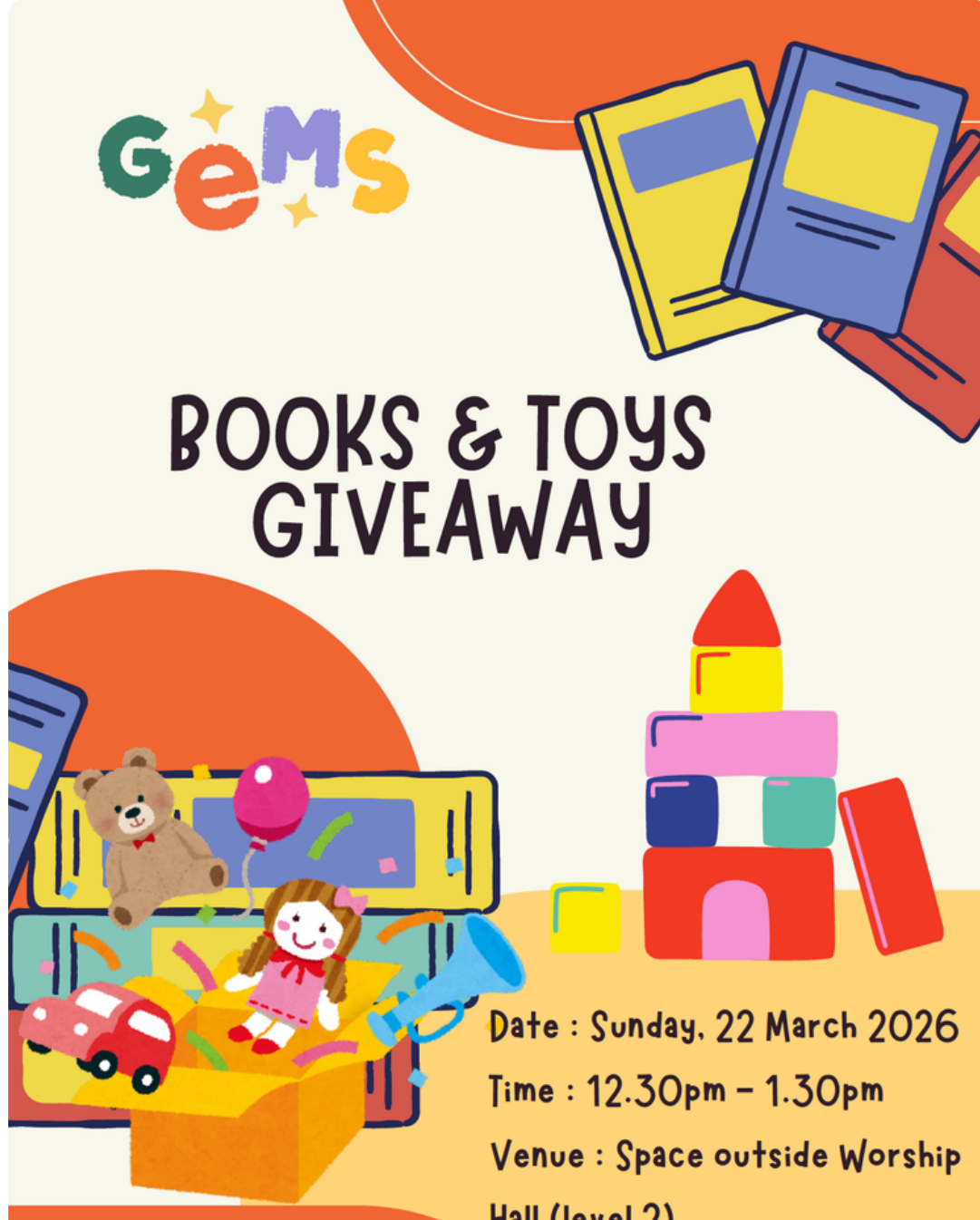

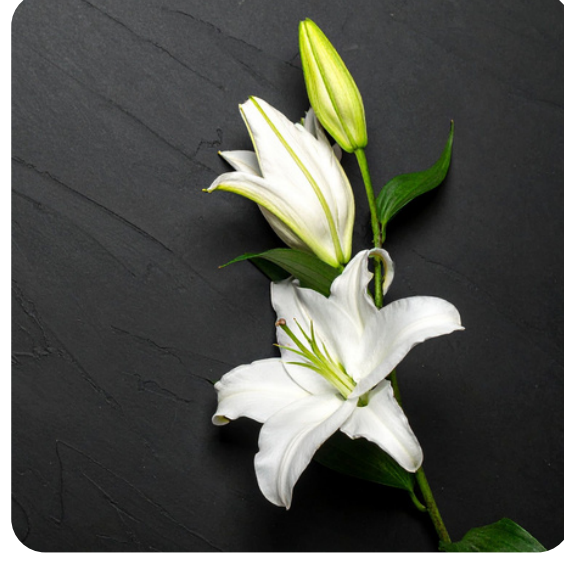
Thanks from Paul Loh
