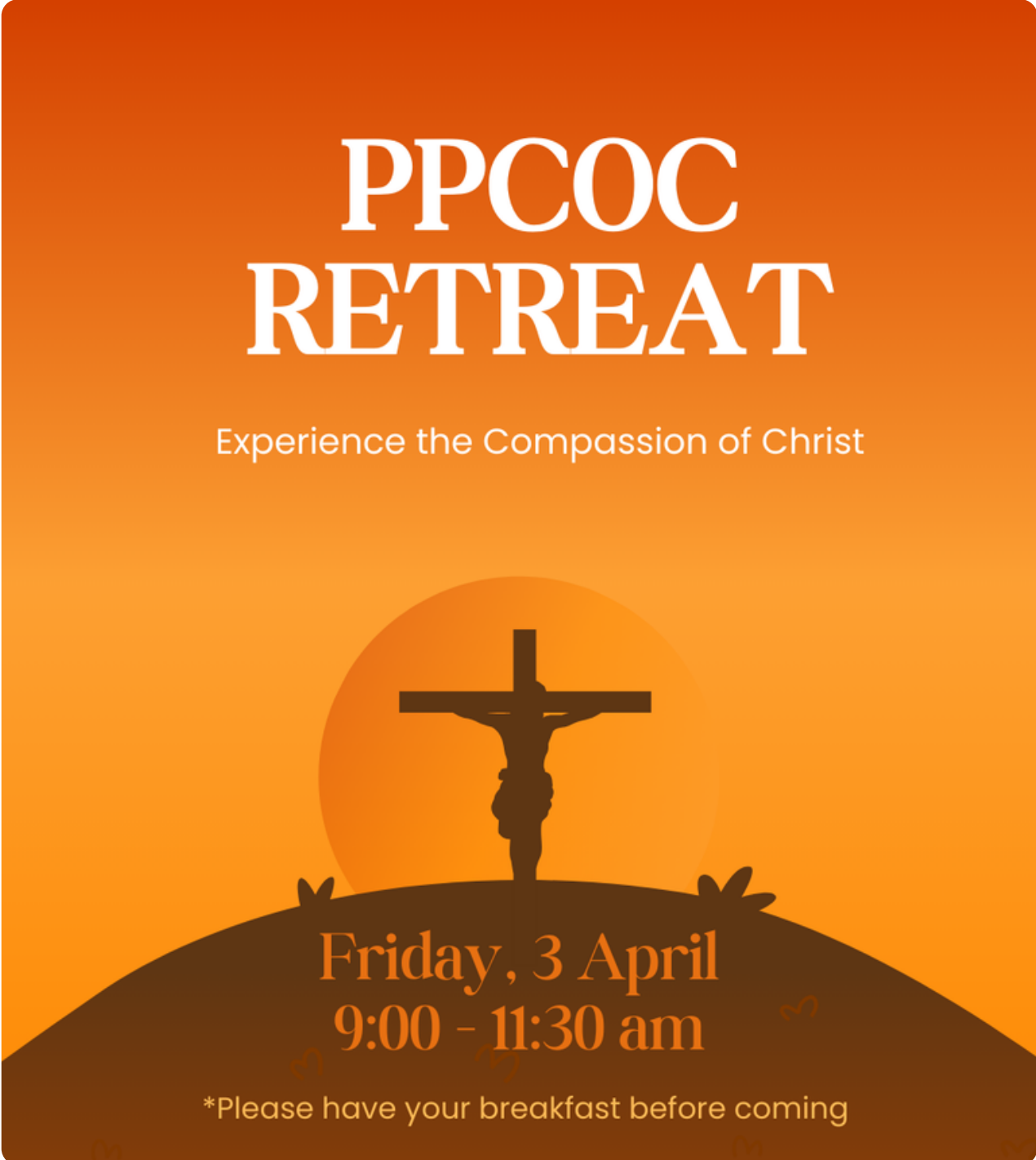
3 April (Good Friday PH)

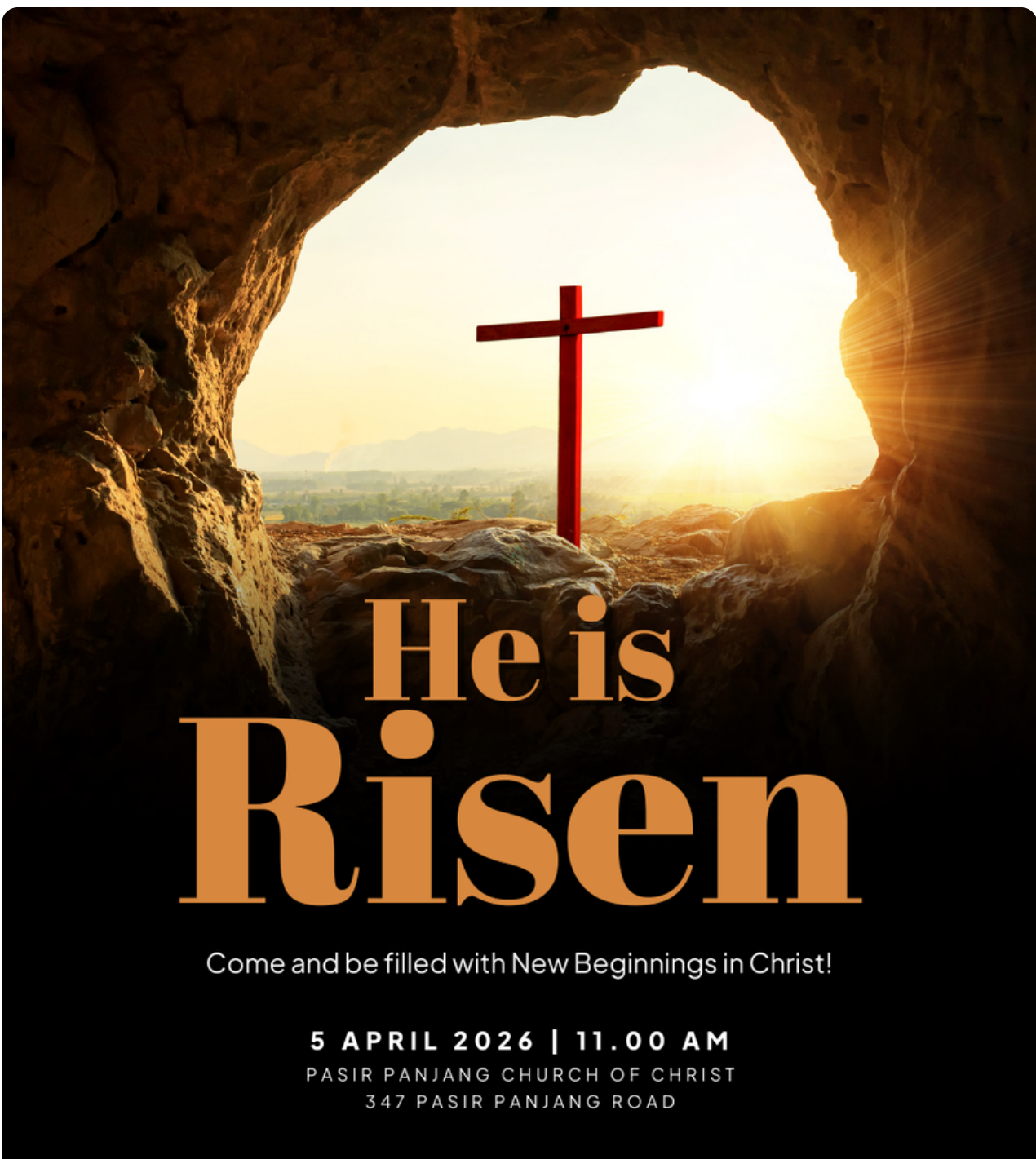


Resurrection Sunday & Family Feast

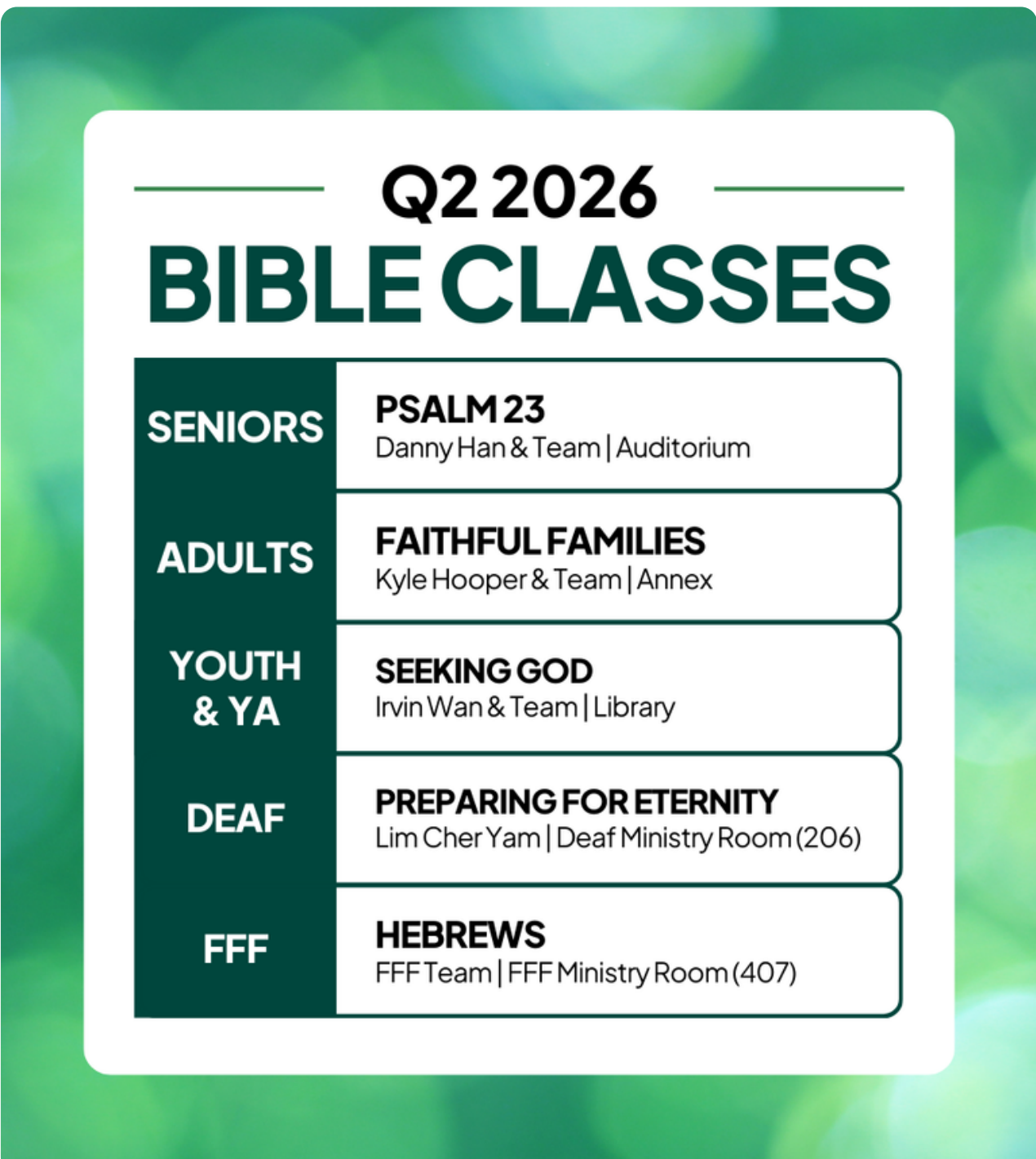


Q2 Bible Classes
